

Shoal Creek Water Festival Boat Race Rules

- 1. The **entire** boat **must be built** from the following materials:
 - Corrugated Cardboard
 - Cardboard "Blocks"
 - Carboard Tubes
 - Duct or Masking Tape
 - Liquid Nail adhesive
 - Latex Paint or Varnish
- 2. The following materials are **prohibited**; **boats using these materials will be immediately disqualified**:
 - Wood
- Staples, clamps, or screws
- Metal

- Caulking Compounds
- Fiberglass
- Silicon, wax, or tar
- Sona-tubes/coated cardboard
- 3. Boats cannot tow anything behind them.
- 4. All persons participating must sign a Participant Waiver prior to the race.
- 5. If a participant is under the age of 12, a guardian or responsible adult must be in the boat with the minor at all times during the race.
- 6. All persons participating **must wear a personal floatation device** and proper footwear at all times during the race.
- 7. All boats must be human powered—oars and paddles are permitted.
- 8. Alcoholic beverages are **prohibited** on the premises before, during, and after the race.

Judges reserve the right to use a probe—such as an ice pick—to test and verify that only the specified materials have been used.

Failure to abide by any of the above rules shall be cause for immediate disqualification.
